TRI-CLUB COMPETITIONS

Each Wednesday during the school holidays, the
Professional Shop organises a stableford sweep on behalf of
Royal County Down GC.

The competitions are open to juvenile members of all three
local clubs and may qualify for handicap purposes (see
competition guidelines).

Entry and all card returns, properly completed and signed
by a marker, **MUST** be made on the day of the competition
through the club's computer system.

Juvenile members must also register at the professional
shop and be ready to play at 12:45pm.

The arranged dates are:

July - TBC

August - TBC

*Note: Due to interclub competitions all dates, especially
for cups and medals, are subject to revision. Members are
asked to check the Juvenile Noticeboard in the clubhouse
regularly. Updates may also be posted on the club's
website and Facebook.*

COMPETITON GUIDELINES

BEFORE PLAYING

1. Ensure you have sufficient funds on your card account to enter the competition. This may be topped up at the bar if appropriate (the computer will warn you when your account balance is less than £5).
2. Write your **Name** on the **Start Sheet** in the Juvenile Locker Room.
3. **Enter the competition via the club's touchscreen computer system (main locker room)**
4. Confirm the **Competition Name, Date, Your Name** and your **current Handicap** on your **scorecard** (add these manually if the label printer is not functioning)
5. Pass the marked up scorecard to the starter (normally a senior member of the club) to organise groupings.

PLAYING

1. The **starter will sort out playing groups**.
2. While they are doing this **get yourself ready to play**.
3. **Stay in your grouping** unless you are told to change by the starter or other club official only.
4. When all members of the group are on the first tee **they must exchange cards**. You cannot mark your own card and everyone is expected to **mark another player's card**. More experienced players should help the younger golfers with this.
5. The group can then start when it is their turn. Lowest to Highest handicap in that order.
6. **Scores must be updated on the scorecard after each hole**. Scores should be agreed with the marker and all members of the playing group before leaving the green. Scorecard checks may be made on the course to ensure compliance.
7. **The marker must initial any corrections or changes made**.
8. **Complete the round according** to the rules of golf.

AFTER THE ROUND

1. **Shake hands and thank** all your playing partners.
2. **Complete cards properly:**
 - **Stroke** – Add up all strokes at each hole for the 18 holes.
 - **Stableford** – mark strokes and points received for each hole and add this up for the 18 holes.
3. **Sign (do not initial) the card you marked** and then **sign your own card after checking it is correct**.
4. Scores to be entered on the **touchscreen computer terminal** in the clubhouse and cards placed in the **competition box in the Juvenile Locker Room**.

NOTE: If you do not follow these guidelines, disqualification and/or suspension may result.

Competitions will only be used to adjust handicaps if:

- a. *The correct competition (back) tees are in play (GUI rule), and*
- b. *Sufficient Numbers Play (Club Rule – normally 8).*

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR JUVENILE PLAYERS

Mourne Golf Club wishes to provide the best possible environment for all young people involved in the game of golf.

Young players are entitled to:

- Be safe and to feel safe
- Be listened to and be believed
- Have fun and enjoy golf
- Have a voice in relation to their activities within golf
- Be treated with dignity, sensitivity and respect
- Participate in an equitable and fair manner and experience competition at a level at which they feel comfortable
- Make complaints and have them dealt with
- Get help against bullies and to Say No
- Confidentiality

Young players should always:

- Treat Sports Leaders with respect, (Professionals, Coaches, Convenors, Club Officials, etc.)
- Look out for themselves and the welfare of others
- Play fairly at all times, do their best
- Be organised and on time and complete the competition they have started
- Respect playing partners even when things go wrong
- Respect opponents, be gracious in defeat
- Abide by the rules set down by team captains when representing the club.
- Behave in a manner that avoids bringing the Mourne Golf Club into disrepute
- Talk to the **Juvenile Convenor** within the club if they have any problems.

Young players should never:

- Cheat
- Use violence or engage in irresponsible, abusive, inappropriate or illegal behaviour
- Shout or argue with officials, playing partners or opponents
- Harm anyone or damage club property
- Bully or use bullying tactics to isolate another player
- Take banned substances, drink alcohol, or smoke
- Keep secrets, especially if they may cause harm
- Tell lies about others
- Spread rumours
- Discriminate against others
